

The Public Safety Committee meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chairperson Marie Fenske.

Members Present: Fenske, Frami, and Remy.

Members Absent: None.

Motion by Remy, second by Frami, to approve the June 13, 2023 minutes.

All voting Aye. Motion carried.

Public Appearances:

- A resident talked about traffic concerns in the city, wrong way parking, bicycle safety and improvements to the Gold Star Trail.

Pedestrian Safety:

- No update on pedestrian crossing lights.
- Operation Frogger Event in the City to target public awareness of crosswalks. Chief Yahnke will investigate how we might achieve this in Horicon.

Safe Routes to School:

- Volunteer crossing guards (adults on Hwy 33 and students elsewhere).
- Chief Yahnke will determine the needs and acceptability of volunteer crossing guards on Hwy 33 for the next meeting.
- Chief Yahnke to find out if the city can get a school zone speed reduction on Hwy 33 where the kids would cross and signage to that affect for the next meeting.
- Chief Yahnke to provide 3 recommended Safe Routes to School.
- Fenske to request parent survey about Safe Routes to School with Horicon School District and St. Stephen's school.

Speed Deterrent Options:

- Tiered options for resident safety requests.
- Will discuss at Public Works and Development Committee to see if they would support this program.

Potential Downtown Outdoor Refreshment Area Ordinance:

- Popular and successful in Oshkosh and Sturgeon Bay where it was first created.
- Target trial period of this for Spring of 2024.

Discussion on safety reminders to residents to lock vehicle doors when they arrive home.

Discussion on police department vehicles and usage.

Motion by Fenske, second by Frami, to approve a 1-year Operator License to Morgan Hope Kjomes, Parker Lynn Litterick and Presley Ann Litterick and a 2-year Operator License to Christine Lynn Thompson Jajko and Delanie Rae Vogt.

All voting Aye. Motion carried.
