



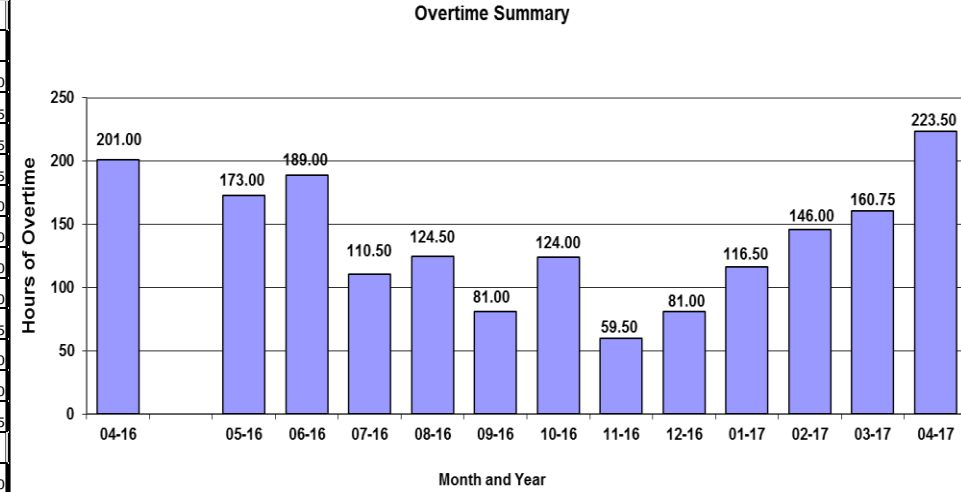
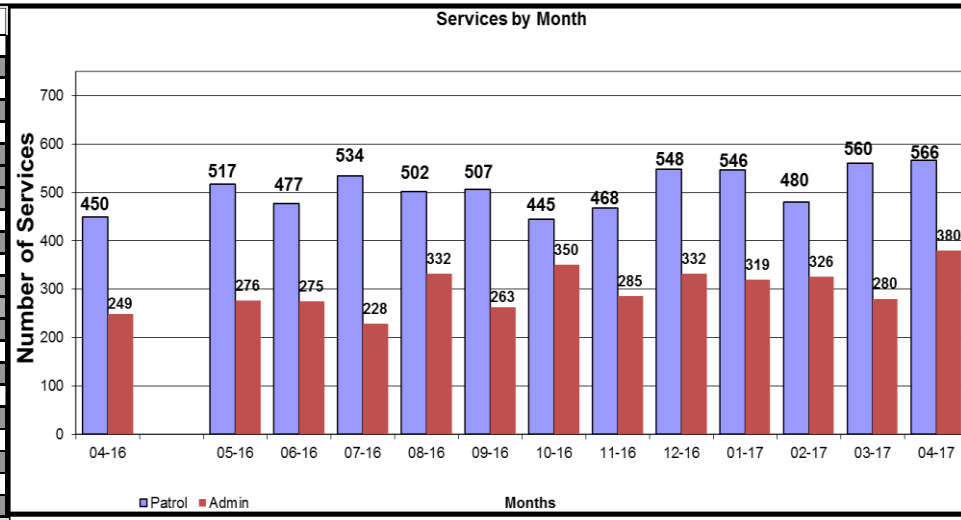

Operations & Training: Calls included 222 security checks, 29 misc calls, 27 follow-up investigative services, 11 car lock-out services, 11 animal complaints, 11 EMS assists, 9 family disturbance services, 8 ordinance violations, 7 welfare checks, 7 parking complaints, 6 disorderly conduct complaints, and 4 traffic crashes (one w/ injuries). Our Adopt-A-Ward program (still not 100% recovered from the server crash) saw 5 awareness for junk accumulation, and 2 citations for improper storage. Our School Partner Program saw participation in High Activity Days at Van Brunt (Bike Rodeo) and 7 lunch visits at the Jr/Sr High School. Our K9 Program had two deployments with one alert resulting in the seizing of 7 OxyContin pills from a vehicle. All officers attended state-mandated In Service this month and individual officers attended homicide investigation update training, scenario based LE training, and Wisconsin Incident-Based Reporting training.

Staffing & Overtime: There were 60 hrs paid-not-worked and 223.5 hrs of OT (132 operational & 91.5 administrative). The majority of OT was to cover shifts as groups of officers attended In Service training. PT Officers worked 17.5 hrs of OT and FT Officers worked 74 hrs of OT. 68 hrs of OT were covered by a supervisor, cover officer, or went unfilled.
