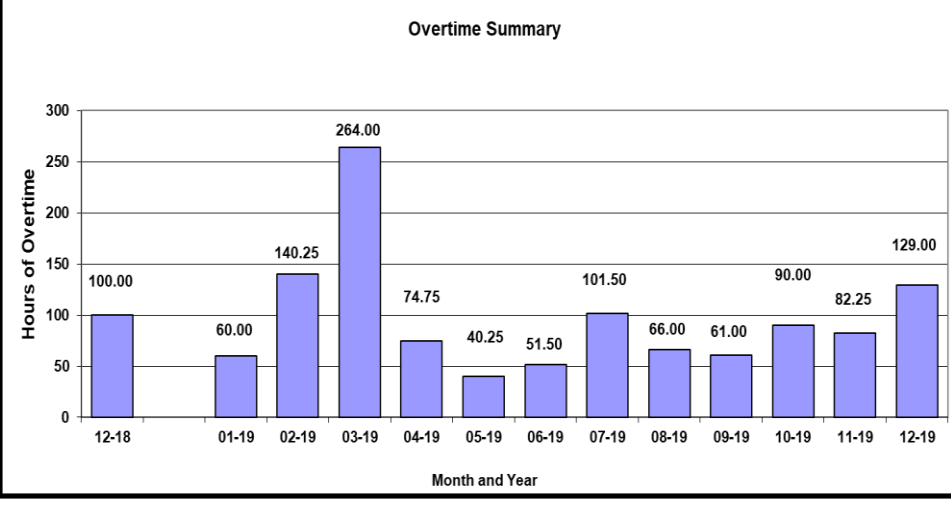
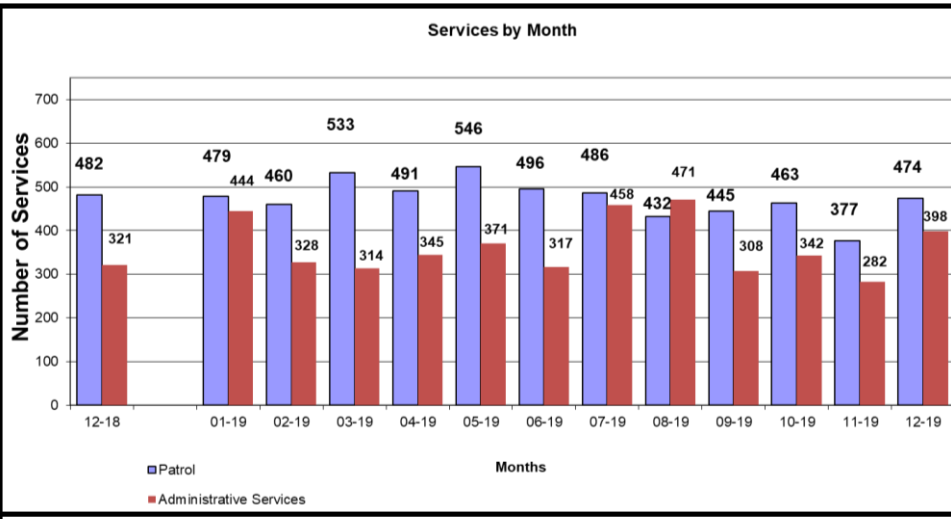

**Operations & Training:** Calls included 181 business/residential security checks, 137 winter parking citations, 25 paper/process services, 24 EMS assists, 19 ordinance violations, 12 mutual aid assists, and 11 traffic complaints. We had an out-of-town "crew" commit a number of thefts from vehicles on Christmas Day. Three suspects were located and interviewed. One was taken into custody. Charges are expected for all three. There were six School Partnership Program engagements and three Adopt-A-Ward contacts (leaves and junk vehicles). We provided 398 administrative services, a significant increase from November. LT Yahnke attended drug-free-workplace training.

**Staffing & Overtime:** There were 244.5 hours paid-not-worked (93 sick, 151.5 vacation or other paid time off). We had one officer out the entire month injured. There were 129 hours of overtime (104 administrative and 25 operational). We had 184 patrol hours that were covered by a supervisor or went unfilled. With the holidays and an injured officer we benefited greatly from co-workers pulling back vacation days and working vacant shifts voluntarily. This was a huge help.
