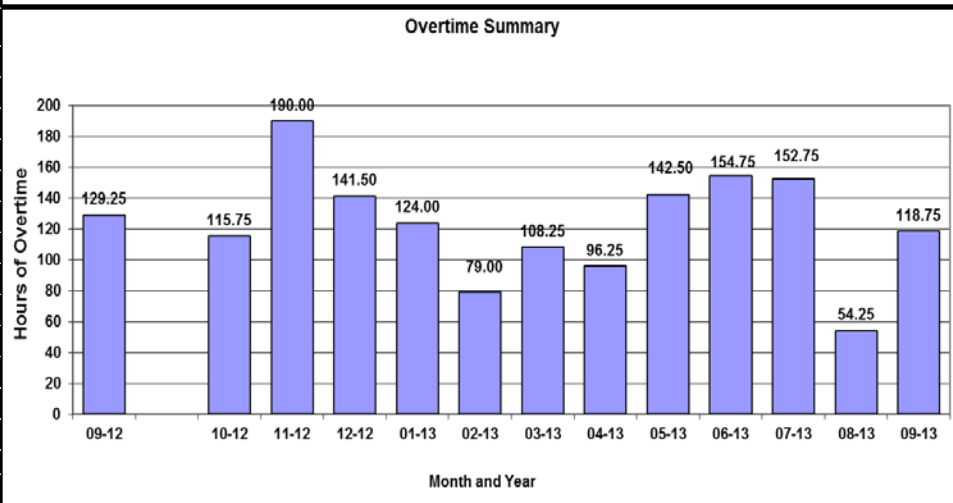
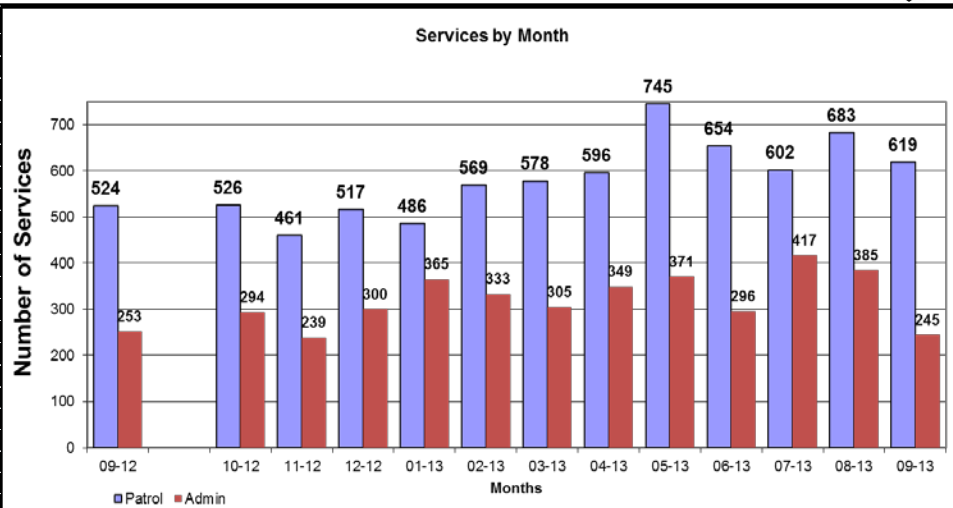

## Chief Adamson's Comments:

➤ **Operations & Training:** September 20<sup>th</sup> marked the transition of mobile data computers county-wide from the "old" computer assisted dispatch software to the "new" computer assisted dispatch software. This is the first in a series of transitions that will be implemented at HPD. The next significant transition is January 1<sup>st</sup> when we convert from our legacy records management software to the new (unified) records management software. Following that will be an internally phased-in system for evidence records, parking enforcement records, property/equipment records, and personnel/training records. Services w/o reports this month included vacation/business security checks (170), traffic stops (95), follow-up investigations (43), paper service (12), and EMS calls (11).

➤ **Staffing & Overtime:** We had 52 hrs of administrative OT & 67 hrs of operational OT; which included annual firearms qualification & department meeting.
