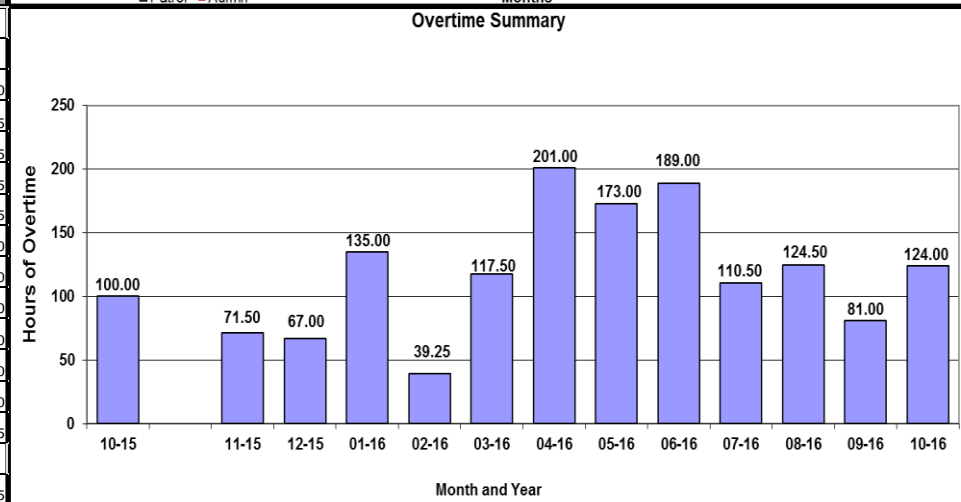
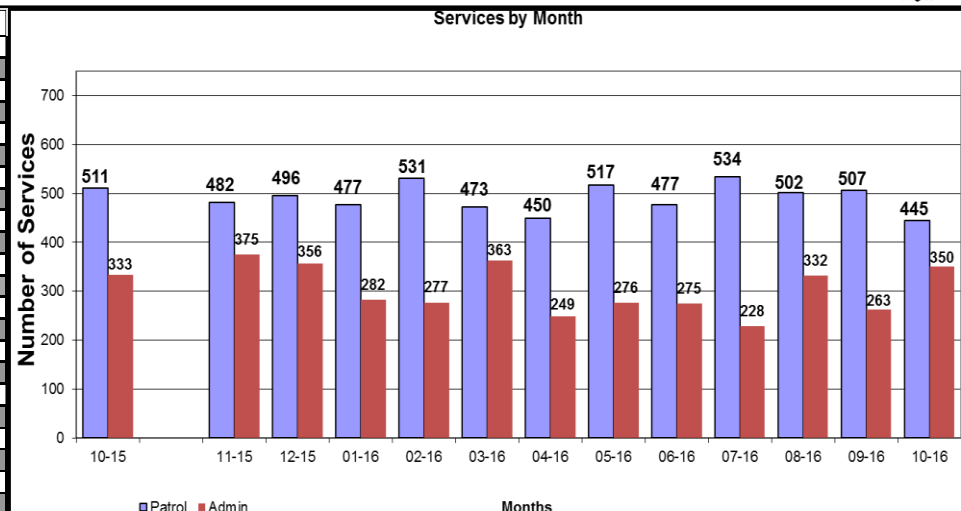

Operations & Training: Calls w/o reports and calls of note included 141 business / residential security checks, 29 paper / process services, 15 EMS assists, 13 follow-up investigative services, 10 disabled vehicle services, 10 animal complaints, 10 suspicious activity calls, 8, theft complaints, and 6 traffic accidents. Adopt-A-Ward saw one contact for improper storage of a camper and a vehicle. Our School Partnership Program saw three presentations to 7th and 8th grade students addressing Bullying and Sexting. Two at the Junior High and one at St. Stephens. Our K9 team participated in a school dance at Van Brunt and was deployed on a vehicle with positive alert (no contraband located). Two FT and one PT officer attended Advanced Law Enforcement Rapid Response Training and one officer attended a software update class for our citation and crash reporting software system.

Staffing & Overtime: Two of our three new PT officers are on solo patrol and actively working shifts when needed. There was 139 hours Paid-Not-Worked and 124 hours of OT (95.5 Administrative and 28.5 Operational) Operational OT included 13 hours for training, 5.5 hours Late Calls, and 10 hours between Court, Special Detail, and Drug Enforcement. There were 69 patrol hours covered by a supervisor, cover officer, or went unfilled.
